This achievement has been the result of significant effort, which began with the approval of the ETSAGr Internationalization Strategy on April 3, 2019, promoted by the then Deputy Director of International Relations, Alejandro Muñoz Miranda. It has culminated in recent months thanks to the actions and work of the current Deputy Director, Francisco Abarca. He has been instrumental in managing courses and obtaining authorization for teaching in English, which have been carried out and funded by our School. As a result, a considerable group of professors have been accredited in the HELA exam, which qualifies them for teaching in English at the university.

In total, there are six subjects spread across various courses, which will allow us to expand our offerings to other foreign universities and, most importantly, enable our students to take courses in English within their own School of Architecture. This offer will continue to grow in subsequent courses.
